Know:

- general laws of the origin and development of life, anthropogenesis and human ontogeny;
- anatomical and individual features of the structure and development of a healthy and sick organism; types of sanitization of patients, types of fevers, peculiarities of observation and care of patients with diseases of various body systems.

- to assess social factors affecting the patient's physical and psychological health: cultural, ethnic, religious, individual, family and social risk factors (unemployment, violence, illness and death of relatives, etc.);
- use medical terminology in Latin;
- to take care of patients of various ages, suffering from diseases of various organs and systems, and their transportation;
- measure body temperature, daily urine output, collect biological material for laboratory research, provide first aid in case of emergency.
