- assess social factors influencing the patient’s physical and psychological health: cultural, ethnic, religious, individual, family and social risk factors (unemployment, violence, illness and death of relatives, etc.);
- use medical terminology in Latin;
- provide care for patients of various ages suffering from diseases of various organs and systems, and their transportation;
- measure body temperature, daily diuresis, collect biological material for laboratory research, provide first aid in emergency conditions.
