1. The purpose of the discipline:

The goal is to teach students the methods of local anesthesia, taking into account its effectiveness and safety, the prevention of emergency conditions and the provision of emergency care in the dental outpatient practice of a dentist surgeon.

Tasks:

- teaching students the methods of local and general anesthesia;
- development of modern means and methods of local anesthesia;
- improving the efficiency and safety of local and general anesthesia; prevention of emergency conditions;
 - provision of emergency care in outpatient dental practice.

2. The place of discipline in the structure of the educational program

The discipline "Local anesthesia and anesthesiology in dentistry" is studied in the sixth semester and belongs to the basic part of Block 1 of the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education in the specialty "Dentistry".

3. Requirements for the results of study of the discipline: The process of studying the discipline is aimed at the formation of the following competencies:

As a result of studying the discipline, the student must *know:*

- physical and chemical properties, classification and mechanism of action. Anesthetic activity and toxicity, duration of action;
- vasoconstrictors: mechanism of action, classification, indications and contraindications for use as part of a local anesthetic solution. Forms of drug release. Storage of carpules and their defects;
 - methods of premedication of dental treatment of patients in outpatient and
- inpatient conditions, the main methods of local and combined anesthesia, topographic landmarks, areas of anesthesia, indications for use; methods of general anesthesia, their characteristics, indications and contraindications for use, means and methods of implementation;
- local and general complications of local and general anesthesia, methods of their prevention and treatment:
 - methods of providing assistance in emergency conditions, methods of providing resuscitation

measures.

Be able to:

- substantiation of the choice of the drug during various outpatient dental interventions;
- to carry out both basic and additional methods of local anesthesia on the upper and lower jaws;
- to conduct psychological preparation of the patient for dental intervention; develop individual premedication schemes for practically healthy patients and patients with comorbidities, assessing the risk of anesthesia and treatment:
- to diagnose emergency conditions in patients at a dental appointment, to provide emergency assistance in the development of local, general complications and terminal condition in a dental clinic;
