"Dentistry: Gerontostomatology and diseases of the oral mucosa"

the main professional educational program of higher education - specialist's programs in the specialty 31.05.03 Dentistry, approved on May 24, 2023

- **1.** The purpose of studying the discipline: training of a dentist who is able to provide outpatient dental therapeutic care to patients with diseases of the oral mucosa.
- **2.** The place of the academic discipline in the structure of the main educational program: discipline refers to the main part of Block 1 of the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education in the specialty 31.05.03 Dentistry..
- **3. Requirements for the results of mastering the discipline**: the process of studying the discipline is aimed at the formation and development of competencies: УК-1, УК-6, ОПК-1, ОПК-5, ОПК-6, ОПК-9, ОПК-13, ПК-1, ПК-2, ПК-4.

As a result of studying the discipline, the student must

Know:

- theoretical foundations of the structure, condition and functioning of the oral mucosa in normal and pathological conditions;
- normal development of the dentoalveolar system;
- classification, etiology, pathogenesis of diseases of the oral mucosa;
- methods of examination, diagnosis, prevention and therapeutic treatment for pathology of the oral mucosa;
- causes of complications in therapeutic practice in the treatment of diseases of the oral mucosa and ways to prevent them;
- the main errors that occur in the treatment of diseases of the oral mucosa, and methods for their prevention and elimination;
- features of the dental status of elderly and senile patients and age.

Be able to:

- conduct a full examination of a patient with diseases of the oral mucosa using additional methods;
- make a diagnosis in accordance with the current classification and conduct differential diagnosis;
- draw up a comprehensive plan for the treatment of the disease, if necessary, with the involvement of specialists from other specialties;
- to treat diseases of the oral mucosa in patients of different ages;

- to carry out preventive measures and educational work in patients with diseases of the oral mucosa;
- identify, eliminate and take measures to prevent possible complications in the treatment of diseases of the oral mucosa;
- to carry out dental treatment of elderly and senile patients;
- If necessary, determine the timing of the medical examination.

Own:

- basic and additional methods for diagnosing diseases of the oral mucosa;
- methods for performing applications, irrigations, washings, injections under the elements of the lesion:
- the ability to fill out medical documentation (case histories, advisory opinions, referrals for laboratory tests, prescriptions);
- perform palpation of regional lymph nodes, facial skeleton, soft tissues of the face;
- perform palpation of the oral mucosa and morphological elements of the lesion;
- to determine the morphological elements of the lesion;
- take material for cytological examination (scrapings, prints)
