Read the text and use it to reproduce the doctor's dialogue with the patient according to the plan: 1. Passport data. 2. Complaints.

On February 25, this year, at 10 a.m., Mikhail Grigoryevich Kuznetsov, 40, was admitted to the hospital No. 64 of the Oktyabrsky district.

Upon the admission, he complained of a severe paroxysmal cough that occurred during the day and increased in the evening. During coughing, the sputum was leaving, first mucous, then — muco-purulent, yellow-green in colour. The patient spat it out several times a day and did not pay attention to the cough. Then his state of health worsened even more: it became painful for him to cough and to

turn on his side. He began to be treated with home remedies: he drank hot tea with honey and raspberries, put mustard plasters on his sides, gargled with warm water and soda, but the effect was insignificant. When the temperature rose, the patient went to the clinic to see a doctor. The doctor examined him, listened to his lungs, tapped his chest, and sent the patient for an X-ray. The patient's condition was getting worse, and no abnormalities were found in the lungs. It was clear that the patient had an acute bronchitis and needed a hospital treatment. The doctor gave him a referral to the hospital.

In the emergency department of the hospital, the patient told about how he got sick and how he was treated, said that he is now much worse than it was 2-3 days ago: at first he had only a cough and a running nose, and a tickle, sore and scratchy throat, and now he can't breathe freely, that sometimes he doesn't have enough air, he feels very weak, can't walk for a long time, that he lost his appetite and began to sleep poorly. And when the doctor asked how long he had been ill, the patient replied that he had been ill for two weeks.

Talking with the patient, clarifying the symptoms of the disease, the doctor was interested in the patient's life. He learned from the patient that he had a good family: a wife, a 20-year-old daughter, a son-in-law and a grandson. He is a Manager by profession and works for a close corporation "Svet". He has a secondary special education. He and his family live on Malaya Bronnaya in a three-room apartment with all amenities. The total area of the apartment is 80 square meters. The apartment is bright, warm, with a balcony. The working space is also good, but there is a lot of dust from passing vehicles: the windows overlook the courtyard, and near the windows there is a grocery warehouse. When he was a child, he suffered from acute bronchitis 2 times, and in 1998 and 1999 suffered from bilateral pneumonia. His relatives did not suffer from lung diseases either on the wife's side or on his side. And he added that no one in their family smokes, nobody has bad habits.
