10. Methodical instructions for students on the development of the discipline

The training consists of classroom classes, including a lecture course and practical classes, and independent work. The main study time is allocated to practical work to consolidate knowledge.

When studying an academic discipline, it is necessary to use theoretical knowledge and master practical skills of working with educational literature and historical sources, as well as analyzing the current social situation.

In accordance with the requirements of the federal state standard of higher education, active and interactive forms of classes are widely used in the educational process (lecture (visualization), discussion (group interviews with and without brainstorming) independent work of students is considered as a mandatory form of education students.

Independent work develops students' ability to work with educational, methodological and reference literature, historical sources. For effective

Mastering of the course material, students are provided with basic literature in the subscription and reading room of the NOSMA library. A mandatory form of independent work is the study of educational, reference literature, taking notes, preparing messages or reports for practical classes, writing an abstract on the chosen topic, preparing for the test.

Writing an abstract contributes to the formation of research skills, the ability to work with scientific literature, to properly design their scientific work in the form of an abstract, the initial level of knowledge of students is determined by testing, the current control of the assimilation of the subject is determined by an oral survey during classes, when solving typical situational tasks and answers to test tasks

At the end of the study of the discipline, an intermediate control is carried out knowledge with the use of test control and verification of practical skills. A systematic approach to the preparation of graduates is ensured by the consistency of the content and the logical sequence of the presentation of the discipline.

To provide methodological support for the development of the discipline, the department has developed teaching aids, where the objectives and methods of conducting classes are described in detail.

Evaluation means of mastering the content of the discipline, give the opportunity to form students' general cultural and professional competencies. Evaluation the quality of mastering the discipline includes the current control of knowledge and intermediate certification (credit). The initial level of knowledge of students is determined by an interview, the current control of the assimilation of the subject is determined by an oral survey during classes, answers to control and test tasks.

13. Conducting educational activities using e-learning and distance learning technologies. In the conditions of introduction of restrictive measures (quarantine) associated with an unfavorable epidemiological situation, the threat of the spread of a new coronavirus infection, and other force majeure events that do not allow conducting training sessions personally, it is possible to study this discipline or part of it using e-learning and distance education technologies. Teaching the discipline in the above situations will be carried out through the development of an electronic course with access to video lectures and interactive course materials: presentations, articles, additional materials, tests and various tasks. When conducting training sessions, current monitoring of academic performance, as well as intermediate certification of students, the Academy's electronic information and educational environment platforms and/or other e-learning systems such as Moodle, Zoom, Webinar and others are recommended for use in the Academy. Lectures can be presented in the form of audio, video files, "live lectures" , etc. Seminars and practical classes can be held on-line in both synchronous and asynchronous modes. Seminars can be held in the form of web conferences
