1. The purpose of the discipline: the development of the discipline of psychology and pedagogy.

2. The place of discipline in the structure of the OPOP VO:

The discipline belongs to the disciplines of the mandatory part / part formed by the participants of the educational relations of Block 1 "Disciplines (modules)" of the Federal State Educational Standards of The Higher Education in the specialty "General Medicine".

To know:

- 4. Definition of memory and determination of attention. Types of memory and types of attention. Properties of attention and memory. Impaired attention and memory. Methods of studying memory and attention.
- 5. Definition of the concepts of "thinking", "imagination", "speech". Types, forms, methods, operations, individual features of thinking. Kinds of imagination. Iatrogenic.
- 6. Definition of "emotion". Classifications of emotions. Functions of emotions.
- 7. Definition of the concept of "personality", "individual", "individuality". "I" the concept and motivation of the individual. The concepts of "character accentuation" and "psychopathy". Types of stress. The influence of stress on the development of psychosomatic diseases. Basic concepts on the topic "Consciousness. Self-awareness. Unconscious"
- 8. Levels of the internal picture of the disease. The scale of the experience of the disease. Types of reaction to the disease. Types of attitude to the disease (Lichko E.A., Ivanov N.Ya.) Psychosocial reactions to the disease.
