Welcome to Montenegro

The picturesque country of Montenegro is a country situated in the southeastern part of Europe. Montenegro has for its neighbors the countries of Serbia to the northeast, Kosovo to the east, Albania to the southeast, Croatia to the west and Bosnia and Herzegovina to the northwest. The country of Montenegro, apart for its scenic mountains, is also known for its out-of-theworld beaches that owe their existence to the proximity that the country enjoys with the Adriatic Sea.

Facts about Montenegro

Montenegro is the first ecological country in the world.

The oldest tree in Europe lives in Montenegrin city Bar: the Old Olive Tree is over 2,000 years old.

The monastery Ostrog is one of the biggest sanctuaries in the world. It is visited by people of all religions.

Name Montenegro in Montenegrin language literally translates to 'Black Mountain'?

There are five national parks, including Durmitor, Lovcen, Biogradska Gora, Prokletije and Skadar Lake.

Length of the sea coast is 293 km with 117 beaches. The longest beach: Velika plaža (Ulcinj) - 13 km.

The road from the beginning plateau for climbing on to the Njegos's mausoleum is made of numerous stony stairway (from the foot up to the entrance into the mausoleum there are 461 staircases).

The Bay of Kotor region is under the protection of UNESCO due to its very rich cultural heritage.

MoMSIC Montenegro

Until 2007. Year MoMSIC was part of YuMSIC (Yugoslovenian Medical Student Association). Since then we are growing as an NMO. As proof of this, MoMSIC Montengro was officially called upon by the government to organize the events and promotion of Pink October, we published the first student's textbook for medical students and we are the main partner with the Montenegrin Institute for Public Health for the Prevention of AIDS program. Beside that, we traditionally organize Teddy Bear Hospital, and also promote healthy lifestyle during: World Hearth Day, World Diabetes Day, World Kidney Day.



About Exchange

The Professional Exchange program is a full educational program offering clerkships to medical students abroad. Since the very beginning, in 1951, it was evident that exchange of medical students would be one of the main fields of action in IFMSA. As early as 1952, a total of 463 students spent a period of practice abroad, and today, it continues to be the backbone of the Federation and constitutes its longest running project. Annually, more than 13.000 students from 90 countries travel around the world to discover new health systems, new cultures and to enhance their global health and intercultural understanding.

The aim of SCOPE is to promote cultural understanding and co-operation amongst medical students and all health professionals, through the facilitation of international student exchanges. SCOPE aims to give all students the opportunity to learn about global health, and attains this partly by having its exchanges accredited by medical faculties across the world.

Objectives

- 1. To increase the mobility and to widen the horizon of medical students worldwide;
- 2. To provide medical students with the possibility to experience healthcare in another culture with different health and education systems, and to learn how differences in culture and believes are of influence;
- 3. To create possibilities for medical students to learn about global health issues, primary health concerns and basic epidemiology of the host country, and how it differs from their home country;
- 4. To contribute to the education of a future health professionals with a global vision and to contribute to medical students personal development, self-reliance and openness in becoming future health professionals;
- 5. To provide students with the chance to improve their medical knowledge, their vision on medical issues and their practical knowledge depending on the regulations of the host country;
- 6. To facilitate the connection of medical students and other health professionals and to provide a platform for future cooperation amongst medical students with each other and with health professionals across the globe;
- 7. To maintain affordable professional exchange tuition through its governing body to ensure that medical students within the National Member Organizations can participate in the exchanges with a minimal financial burden;
- 8. To make sure students are aware of the ethical aspects regarding their exchange to assure the burden on society, patients, the recourses and the healthcare system is as limited as possible;

About Berane

Berane (Montenegrin and Serbian Cyrillic: Беране) is one of the biggest towns of northeastern Montenegro and a former administrative center of the Ivangrad District. It is a seat of one of many multi-ethnic and multi-religious municipalities in Montenegro. The town is located on the Lim river. Its name is derived from the Turkish word meaning "One house". The town has a population of over 11 thousand, whereas its municipality area reaches 34 thousand people, making it one of the largest centres of Polimlje area.

Main Hospital Berane

In the area of health care, the municipality of Berane is at the very top of the Montenegrin Health whose development strategy is envisaged that Berane become a regional medical center.

Organized Health Service was established at the end of 1919, the formation of the hospital in Berane.

General Hospital Berane is a modern medical institution, medical practice base of Faculty of Medicine Podgorica, University of Montenegro. The 7,357 square meters of space are situated departments: gynecological (including maternity), surgery (including urology), internal (with the service for hemodialysis), infectious, pediatrics, department of anesthesia and resuscitation, transfusion, clinical and biochemical laboratories, X-ray. Annually it about seven thousand hospitalized patients, perform over two thousand operations, and during the year more than a thousand born babies.
















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


Organization.
